Overview	In this lesson, 6th grade choir students will participate in a word sort activity.
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Computer with Projector or Smart Board• Individual Whiteboards and Dry-Erase markers• Word Sort - Grade 6 Choir
Instructions	<p>Teacher will project the Word Sort Google SLIDE presentation on their screen or Smart Board. If you do not have this technology, you may elect to write the words on large whiteboard in front of the class.</p> <p>Students each get a whiteboard and a dry-erase marker to complete the activity. If resources are slim, students can work in small groups of no more than 4 students per board.</p> <p>Students categorize music vocabulary terms by placing them into one of 4 boxes on their whiteboard. When they are done, they will show you their boards.</p> <p>Pay close attention to spelling. I will tell a student they still have one word incorrect if it's spelled wrong even if it's in the right category. When a student or group has every word spelled correctly and in the correct category, they get to erase their board and put away their materials.</p> <p>This activity is great for reviewing vocabulary words before a test.</p>
