9th Grade - Sentinel School Tour

Overview:

This lesson, Sentinel School Tour, will incorporate student collaboration while learning to use Google Maps to create a campus tour, which will include hidden curriculum within the school.

Materials:

Video - Google Maps in Education

Instructions:

- Show video on Google Maps
- Discuss Google Maps and ask class what they wish they would have known before they started school (create a list of hidden curriculum)
 - Hidden curriculum can be information that we assume others know about
 Sentinel, but are not told. For instance, where can their lockers be located, what kind of locks are required for the lockers, and where do I eat lunch?
- Break class into groups of 3 or 4
- Groups will create a lesson for incoming students that will include:
 - Google Maps tour of campus
 - A video or brochure about the hidden curriculum of Sentinel
- Share final project with class
