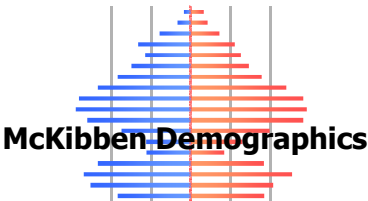

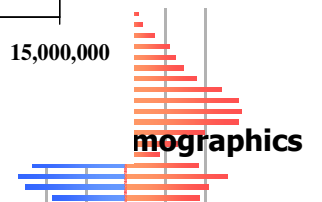
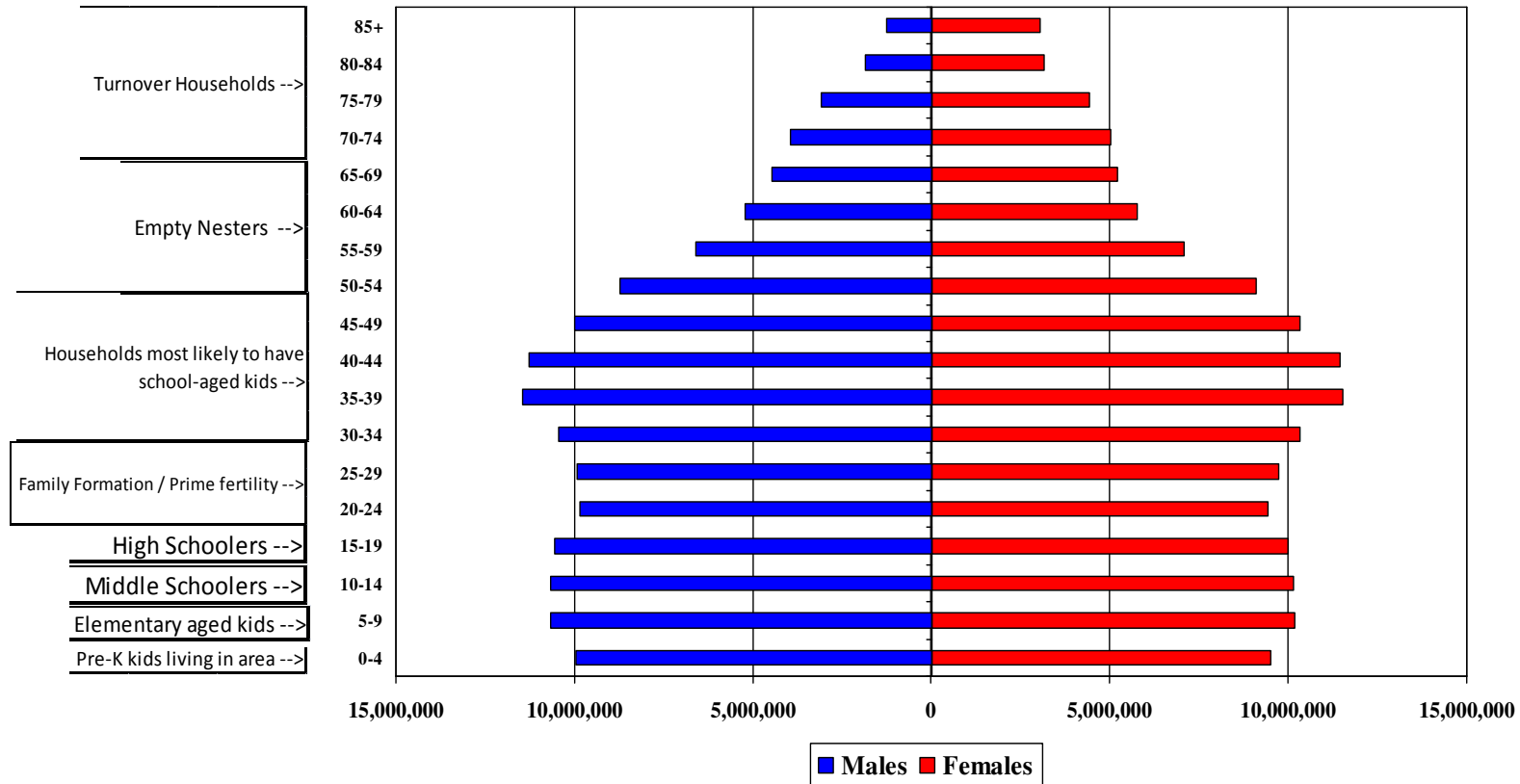


How to Read a Population Pyramid

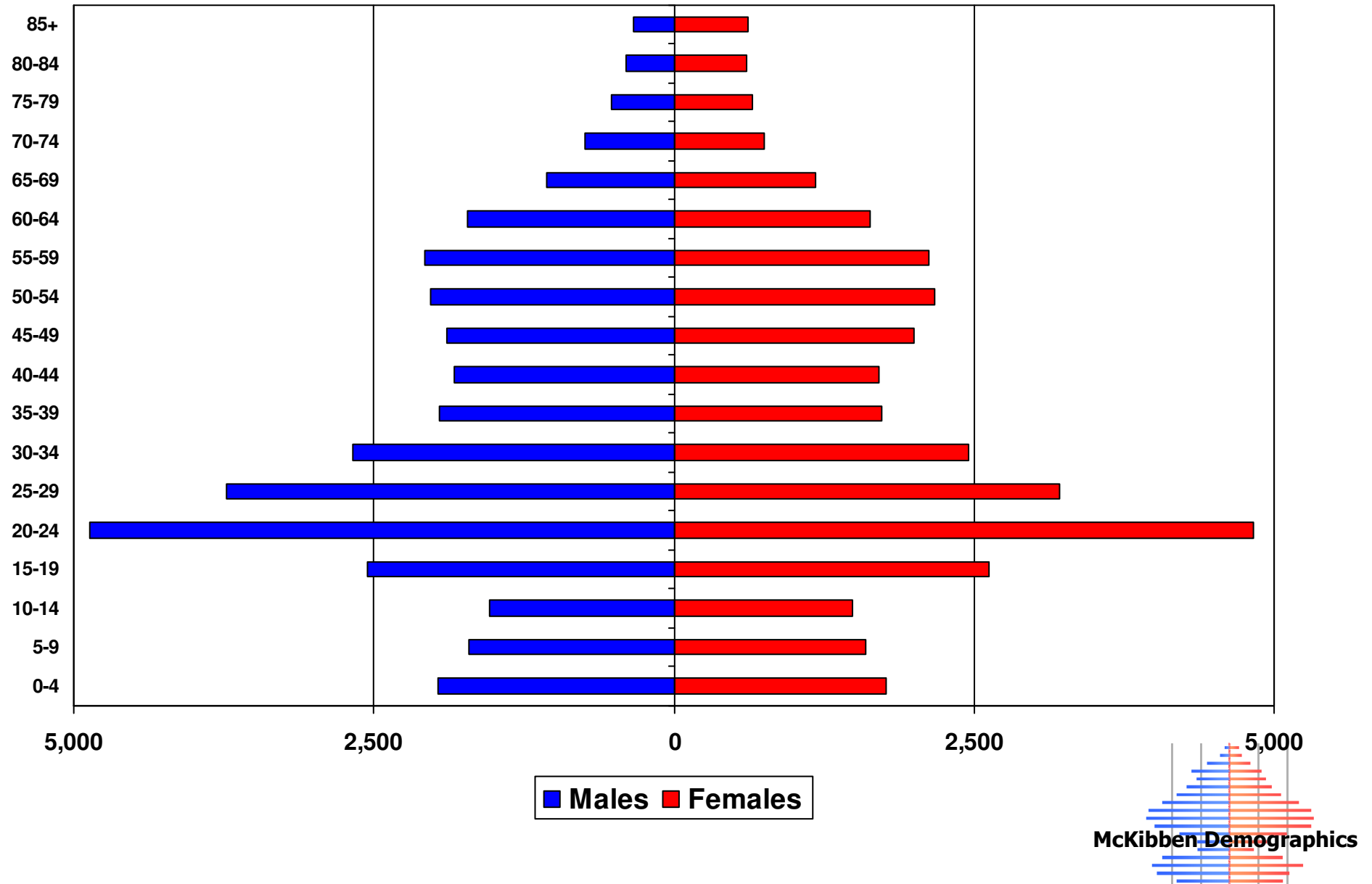
Areas with majority of householders 40-55 are most likely to have a decline in household size over the next 10 years as their children move out of the house / go off to college, hence an overall decline in enrollment.

Areas with majority of HH 20-35 are most likely to have increase in HH size over the next 10 years as they have kids and they age into the schools.

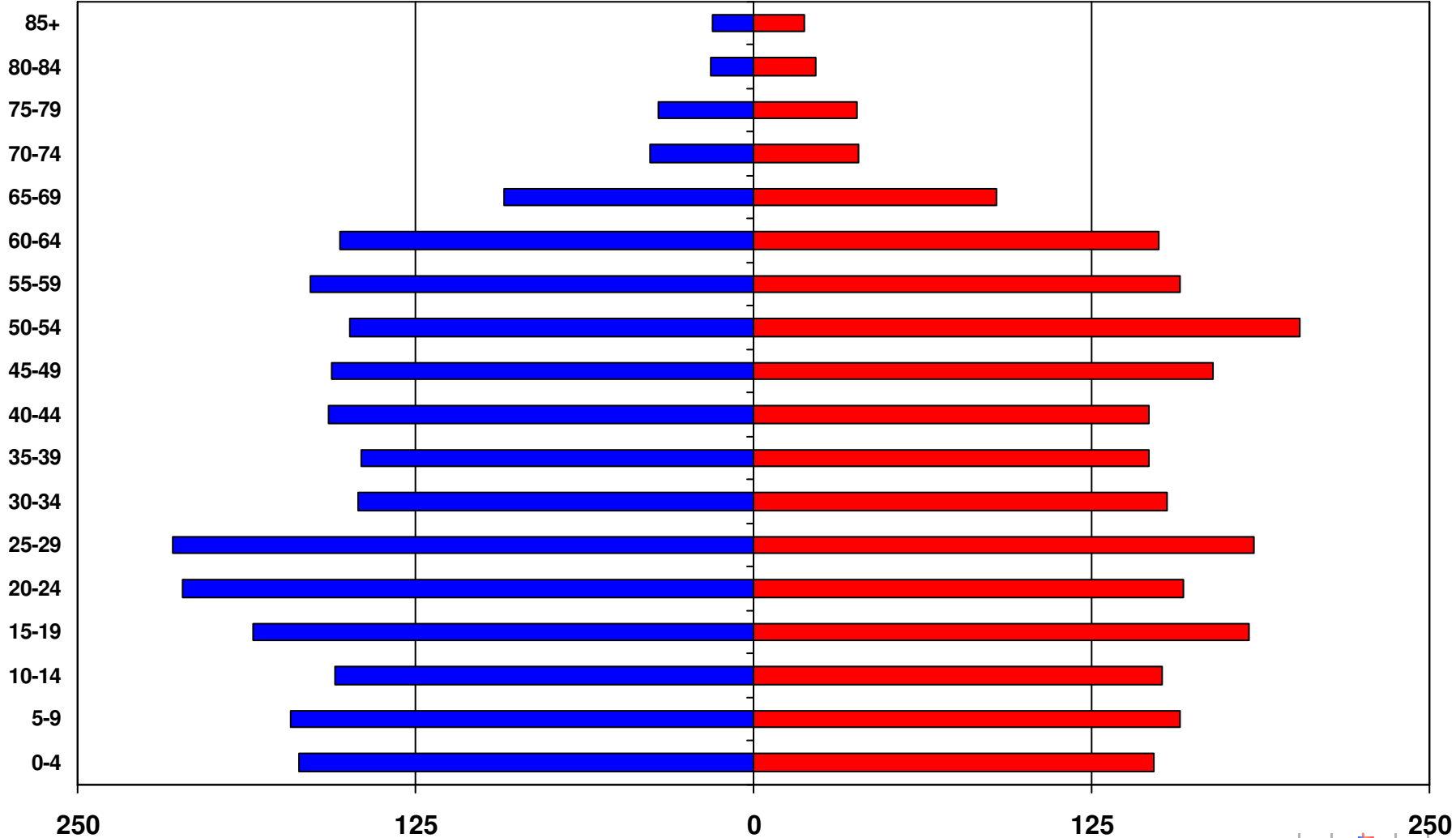
Areas with colleges inside will show a large cohort in this level. These can be isolated by removing group quarters population.



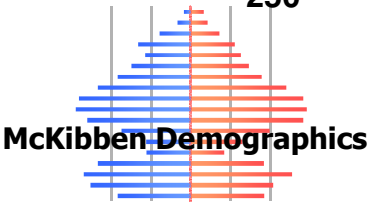

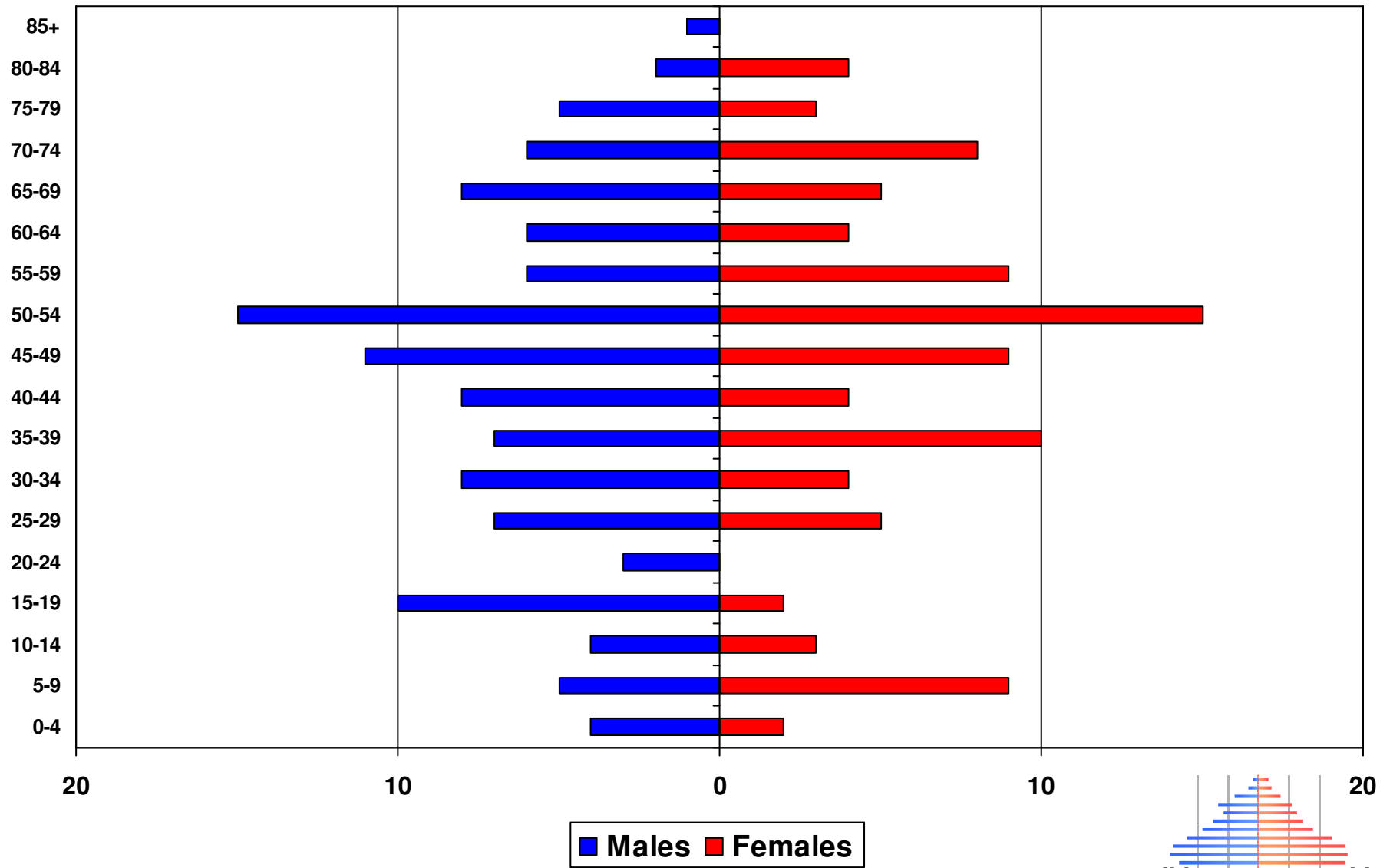

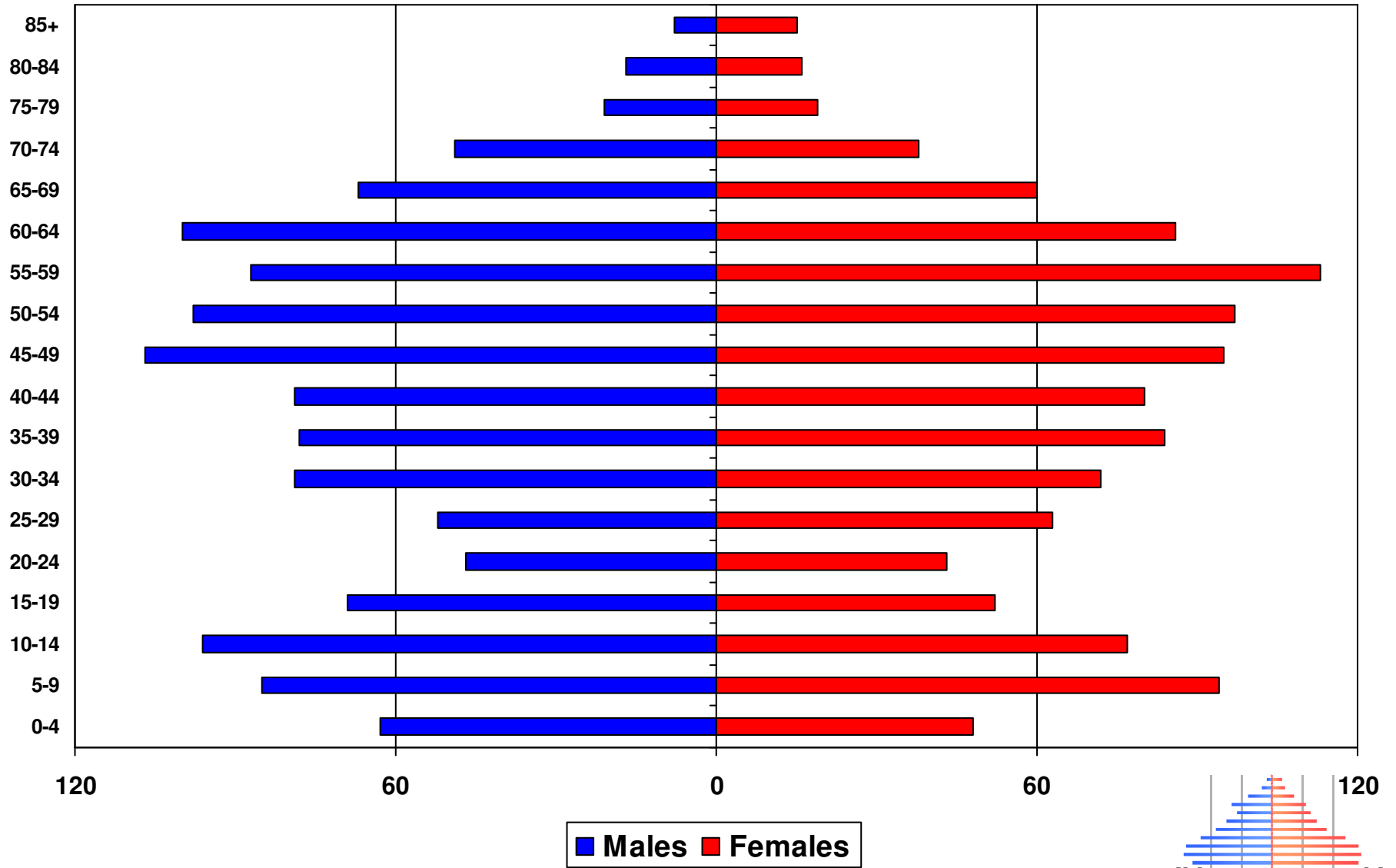

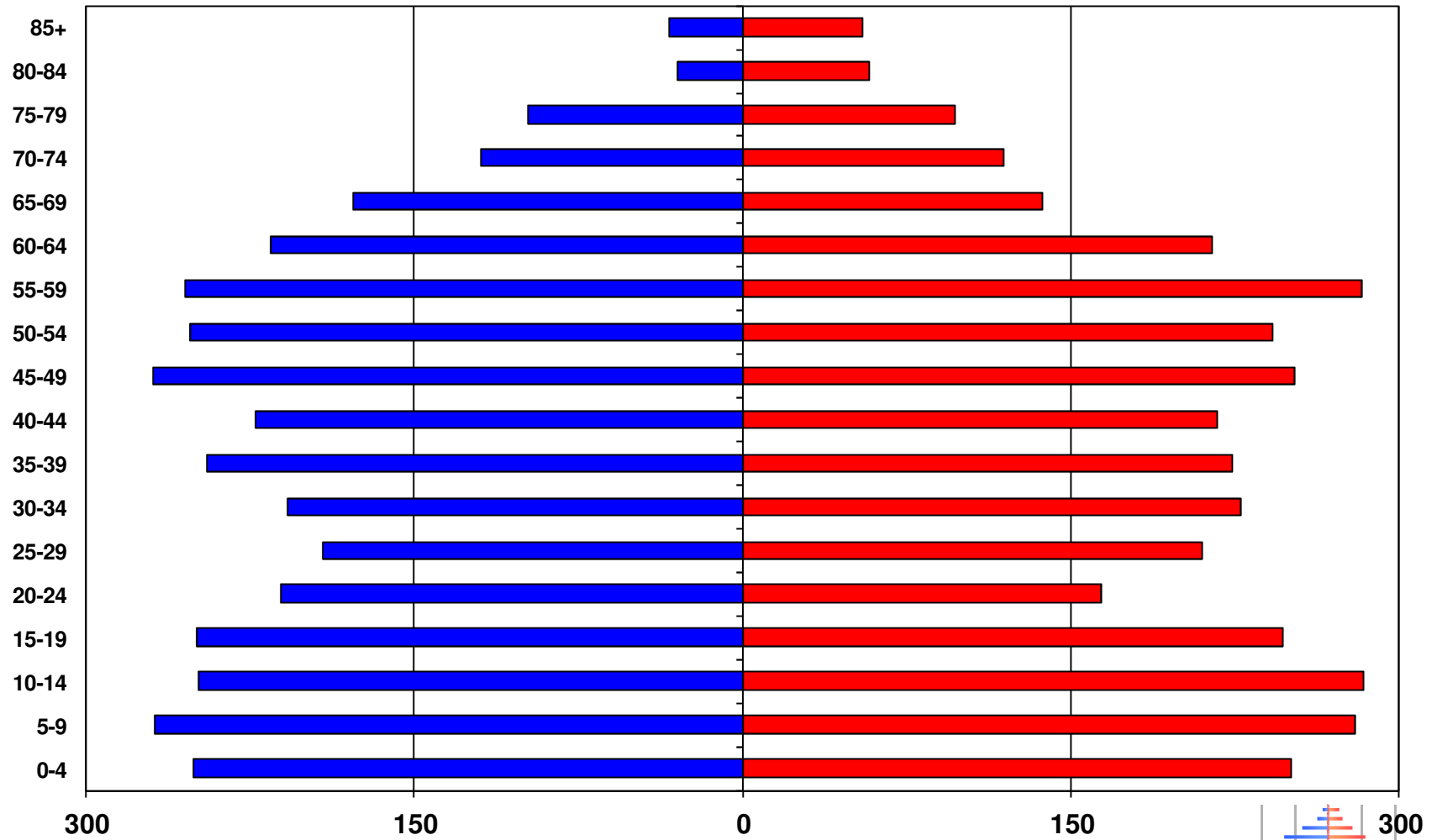
