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MCPS Facilities Strategic Planning Process Overview

Missoula County Public Schools started a Comprehensive Long Range Facilities Planning Process across the district. The planning process is dynamic, creative and engaging. It builds upon the MCPS's 21st Century Initiatives and focuses on education first, then facilities.

Education Innovation Teams from each school have developed a range of options for their school buildings across the district:

- Option B Business as Usual
- Option C Consolidate
- Option L Light Touch
- Option O Out of the Box
- Option R Realign & Relocate
- Option S Start Over

The committee and the community will explore this range of options and make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees will be responsible for all decisions related to school sites.

The process has 5 steps:
(prepare) April-September 2013
ASSESS October 2013
EXPLORE November 2013
APPLY December 2013
(report) December 2013-March 2014
