As a part of our units of study, we may be viewing R-rated film(s) or scenes from R-rated film(s). It is important that you know these films may be included in a unit of study so you can decide whether or not you wish to grant permission for your child to view the film(s). The educational objectives include:

- Analyze and critique how production elements and techniques are used to create specific effects.
- Analyze how contextual variables affect the interpretation of the media message.
- Analyze and critique the credibility of a media communication by evaluating accuracy and relevancy to the original text.
- Critique and analyze a director's use of cultural and historical references to achieve specific purposes.
