

2J Classroom - Frequently Asked Questions



Q: Do the supplies that I buy for my child stay with my child or do they become community property?

A: Your child will keep and utilize the supplies that you purchase for their individual school needs.

Q: What time is early-out dismissal?

A: Early-out is every Thursday at 2:10

Q: Can you assign alternative math homework for my child?

A: Your child's online My Path homework is set to their individual level, which personalizes their instruction, and prepares them for their triannual MCPS district math assessment. Students that complete their iReady math homework have scores that are typically much higher than those that do not use the program. If your child is not able to do their math homework at home, we will have them complete their minutes during the school day rather than assign alternative homework.

Q: Can you adjust my child's iReady math placement?

A: Yes - let me know if you think your child's placement level is inappropriate. I will take a look and adjust it accordingly.

Q: Can I send a birthday treat to school on my child's special day?

A: Due to food restrictions and allergies, we do not celebrate with a treat, but we will make your child feel special all day, starting with surprises at their table spot when they arrive in the morning. A special birthday book to bring home will be created and gifted to your child by their classmates.

Q: Can I send birthday invitations to school to be passed out by my child?

A: To protect the feelings of our friends, please do not send party invitations to be passed out at school unless the whole class is invited.

Q: How can I volunteer in my child's classroom?

A: I will email families when volunteer opportunities arise. If you have a special skill or talent that you think might tie to the curriculum, please reach out, and we can set something up for you to present or be a guest teacher.
