

MathCounts

Like everything in our world, Washington Mathcounts looked different this year. We held virtual and in-person meetings for students who wanted to participate in WMS Mathcounts. All of the Mathcounts competitions were virtual and the progression from one competition level was different than what we had ever previously experienced. All of our WMS Mathcounts participants took a chapter qualifier virtual test in early February. From this test, the top 20% in our region qualified to participate in the official Western Montana Chapter competition on February 25th. Four Washington Middle school students placed in the 20% in our chapter invitational: Brendan Cowie (8th grade), Jake Peng (8th grade), Brynn Allred (7th grade), and Isaac Lukacs (6th grade).

These four students competed in the official chapter competition on February 25th. From this competition, the top 10 in the state plus the top 20% in each region were invited to compete in the state Mathcounts competition.

2021 WMS Chapter MathCounts Results:
Brendan Cowie placed 1st
Jake Peng placed 4th
Brynn Allred placed 10th
Isaac Lukacs placed 11th.

With these chapter results (Brendan and Jake placed in the top 10 in the state, and Brynn and Isaac placed in the top 20% of our region) all four WMS students advanced to the State Mathcounts competition, held virtually on March 25th. We won't learn the results of that competition until April 2nd. If any of the students place in the top four in the state, they will move on to a virtual National Mathcounts competition in May.

Congratulations to Brendan, Jake, Brynn, and Isaac for their 2021 Mathcounts success this year. Your dedication and hard work is admirable. We are very proud of each of you.
