Having worked with kids for the past fifteen years, the problems that students encounter as part of this program develop and hone problem solving skills and introduce kids to a wide array of topics in mathematics, including geometry, algebra, probability, number theory, and statistics to name a few.

Students are encouraged to come to our WMS Mathcounts meeting if they simply enjoy mathematics and love a challenge. Students do not have to compete and can make a decision later if they may or may not be interested in Mathcounts competition.
