Montana College Application Week October 1st-5th

Montana College Application week allows Montana Seniors the opportunity to complete 1 College Application to a Montana School for free (applications fees are waived or deferred depending on the school)!

Hellgate seniors can stop into the Counseling Center during Monday through Wednesday and Friday from 7:30-3:30 and Thursday between 7:30-2 to receive help completing a montana college application. We highly recommend that students consider stopping by during Senior Study Hall, Study Hall, lunch or Office Hours.

Missing Work Deadline October 3rd

Any missing work from August and September must be turned in by October 3rd.

<u>PSAT</u> <u>Wednesday, October 10th</u>

The PSAT will be administered on **Wednesday October 10, 2018 ONLY**. Testing will begin promptly at 7:50, we encourage students to arrive early. Only pencils and calculators will be allowed in the testing room. **No Cell Phones or backpacks will be allowed.** Please prompt your student to leave them in a safe place.

Registration is now open. There are a limited number of tests available, so to ensure a spot, sign up immediately. The test will cost \$16. <u>Juniors</u> on free and reduced lunch are eligible for a scholarship; <u>please see Jeanie Hughes in the front office to register for the PSAT</u>. Students will receive a test prep booklets upon registration. Those that previously registered and did not get a booklet, can do so now with Jeanie. Students can complete a green Counselor Appointment Request form to request an appointment with their Counselor. Counselors will send a pass for this student when they are available to meet with the student.

College Applications

Many colleges and universities are utilizing Common Application or SendEdu for their application process. This is convenient for students and recommenders because everything can be done online. Counselors will receive a request for a recommendation through email. Your student should check with their Counselor to ensure they received the request. Requestors also needs to provide their Counselor with a current Resume at least 2 weeks prior so that we can write a comprehensive letter of recommendation. Please make sure to use the mcps.k12.mt.us e-mail addresses for Counselors.

Transcript Requests

Official Transcripts can be ordered through the HHS Registrar, Lori Willumsen. Students and parents can either complete a Transcript Request Form or submit a request to Lori through e-mail at lwillumsen@mcps.k12.mt.us. Transcript Request Forms can be picked up at Lori's desk. If making a request through e-mail, please be sure to provide your student's name as well as the name and address of the institution it will be sent to. lwill be sent to. Please provide your request at least 48 hours before you need your transcripts. Unofficial transcripts can be viewed on student and parent Q.

College and Military Visits

Juniors and Seniors are invited to attend college, military and career visits at Hellgate High School. Students are asked to complete a Post-Secondary Visit Form (Blue Form found on the bulletin board across from the Counseling office). Please speak with your teacher and get their signature ahead of time, attend the visit, turn in your Post-Secondary Visit form to your Counselor and we will School Relate your absence for the class period.
