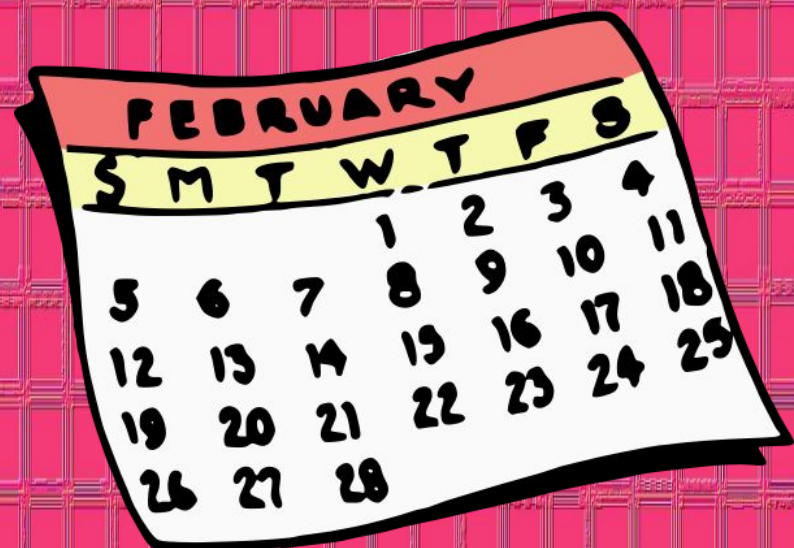

The application must be submitted by March 15th. Students should have received a flier about the process during the first or second week of January. Students must submit a 7th semester transcript with the application; these are currently being finalized.

Seniors! Please Read!

The grading deadline for semester 1 has been extended to February 7th. Official transcripts will be delayed for the first semester.

This will delay Common App mid-year reports and sending of official transcripts. We know colleges are reaching out to you for mid-year reports. Please know that we will complete them once transcripts are finalized.

All other Official Transcripts can be ordered through the HHS Registrar, Lori Willumsen. Students and parents can either complete a Transcript Request Form or submit a request to Lori through email at lwillumsen@mcpsmt.org.

Transcript Request Forms can be picked up in the front office. If making a request through email, please be sure to provide your student's name, graduation year as well as the name and address of the institution it will be sent to. Please provide your request at least 48 hours before you need your transcript.

Now is a good time to review your student's graduation requirements and start the discussion about what courses they may want to take next year and what courses they may still need for graduation.
