Class Lists

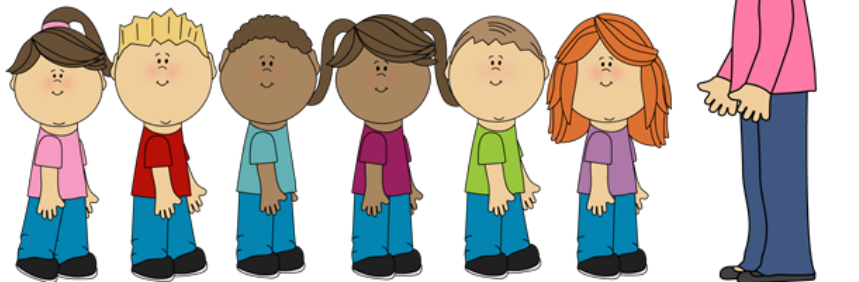
