Travel	Travel restrictions have been removed. Airlines, cities, and states have removed Covid restrictions.
COVID Testing	The District offers on-site Covid testing as well as free home kits
Vaccines	Vaccination is a family decision. The District supports/encourages vaccination.
Visitors	Adults may volunteer or visit schools if they are not showing signs of illness
Face Coverings	Face coverings are a personal decision. Face coverings are welcomed if students/staff choose to wear one.
Other	Crowd size at events is now unlimited for 22-23

Schedule	 Two middle schools operate on a 9 period day. One middle school operates on a modified block schedule
Other	Students attend all classes throughout the week

Times	 9-12 school day begins at 8:55 and ends at 3:55
Schedule	 All high schools have a 7 period day with a modified block day on Wednesday and Thursday
