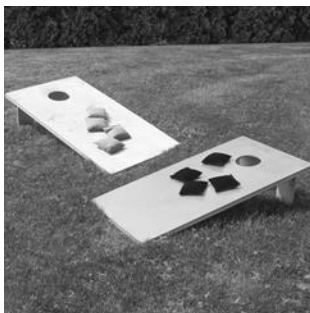


## Scrambled Legs
