## NOTICE OF ELECTION

Missoula County Public Schools Elementary School District No. 1, Missoula County, Montana, will hold an election on May 2, 2017, at Missoula County. This will be a mail ballot election for the purpose of voting on the following:

### **GENERAL FUND LEVY ELECTION\***

#### **Missoula County Public Schools - Elementary District No. 1**

Shall the Missoula County Public Schools' Elementary District Trustees be authorized to levy an increase in local taxes to support the general fund in the amount of Eight Hundred Four Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-One Dollars (\$804,861), which is approximately 7.35 mills, for the purpose of instruction and operation of the elementary schools? This levy will be an increase to the existing voter-approved levy.

Passage of this proposal will result in an annual tax of approximately \$9.92 on a home with an assessed property value of \$100,000, and \$19.84 on a home with an assessed property value of \$200,000. The durational limit of the levy is permanent once approved by the voters, assuming the District levies that amount at least once in the next five years.

VOTERS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE COUNTY ELECTION ADMINISTRATOR TO BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE. ABSENTEE BALLOTS MAY BE OBTAINED BY APPLYING IN WRITING OR IN PERSON WITH THE ELECTION ADMINISTRATOR, MISSOULA COUNTY COURTHOUSE, BEFORE NOON ON MONDAY, MAY 1, 2017. YOU MAY CALL THE ELECTION OFFICE AT 258-4751 WITH QUESTIONS.

\*When the trustees call a school election, they shall give notice of the election not less than 10 days or more than 40 days before the day of the election by posting notices in three public places in the district. (MCA Section 20-20-204)
