6th Grade

- Backpack
- Gym shoes/shorts or sweats/shirt/socks
- Trapper Keeper style binder (preferably with accordion pockets), or 3" 3-Ring Binder, or (5) 1" Binders
- (2) 1" Binders for Exploratory classes
- 3-hole, loose-leaf, lined notebook paper, (load your binder and keep some at home)
- (25+) Pencils with erasers and a personal pencil sharpener or mechanical pencils
- (5) dividers with pockets
- (3) One subject spiral notebooks
- Red & blue/black pens (5 of each)
- Colored pencils
- Pencil pouch for binder
- Calculator (4 function: +/-/x/÷) – typically a \$1 solar calculator is fine.
- (1) Book cover
- Optional: Headphones or ear buds (in a plastic bag and labeled), highlighters, sticky notes, tissue, glue sticks, scissors, markers/crayons, locker magnets/locker organizer
