

What kind of files can I use in Movie Maker?

You can add the following types of video, photo, and audio files to Movie Maker.

Video files

Video file types (format)	File name extensions
Windows Media Video (WMV) files	.wmv
Windows Media files	.asf and .wm
AVCHD files	.m2ts, .mts, and .m2t
Apple QuickTime files	.mov and .qt
DV-AVI files	.avi
Microsoft Recorded TV Show files	.dvr-ms and .wtv
MPEG-4 movie files	.mp4, .mov, .m4v, .3gp, .3g2, and .k3g
MPEG-2 movie files	.mpeg, .mpg, .mpe, .m1v, .mp2, .mpv2, .mod, .vob, and .m2t
MPEG-1 movie files	.m1v
Motion JPEG files	.avi and .mov

Audio files

Audio file types (format)	File name extensions
Windows Media Audio (WMA) files	.asf, .wm, and .wma
Pulse-code Modulation (PCM) files	.aif, .aiff, and .wav
Advanced Audio Coding (AAC) files	.m4a
MP3 files	.mp3
