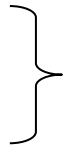


Learning Targets for Movie Creation

Steps for Windows Movie Maker

1. Create a folder for the Movie Maker project and all the files to import. All files to import for the project need to be saved in this folder.
2. Create a Title page- Home tab
3. Begin importing your files- make sure they are compatible with Movie Maker
4. Make sure you save your project into the folder you created. Save often (every 5 minutes)
5. Begin editing the video for transitions and effects – Edit, Animations or Visual Effects tabs
6. Edit the length of clips by selecting the clip- Right click for options
7. Create a credits page- Remember to give credit for any one's creations
8. Convert your project into a standalone movie- File/Save Movie/For Computer
 - a. Browse to the location of the MPEG-4 file type
 - b. Name the movie
 - c. Follow the wizard steps
